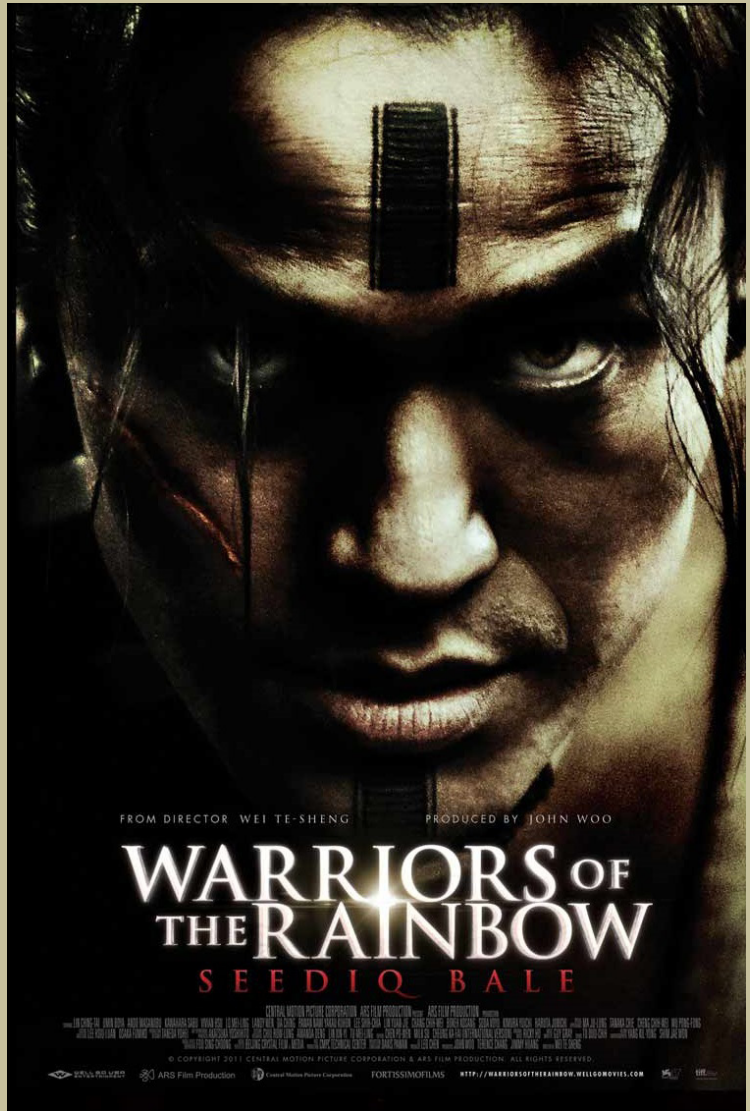


CENTER FOR TAIWAN STUDIES AT UCSB PRESENTS

Part Two of Wei Te-Sheng's epic film, *Warriors of the Rainbow*, reclaims an extraordinary episode in Taiwan history. The film *Seediq Bale* - heroes of the tribe - depicts the Wushe Incident, which occurred near Qilai Mountain of Taiwan under Japanese rule. Mona Rudao, a chief of Mahebu village of Seediq people, led warriors fighting against Japanese colonial rule, which threatened local traditions and identities.
